#### Federal Programs Information

- Needs assessment surveys for Title I were given to parents at Parent/Teacher Conferences and will be analyzed to identified needs of the program and professional development for the elementary.
- We have had 15 referrals for special education services. 6 students have qualified for services, 4 students did not qualify for services 3 are in the final stages of the evaluation process 1 student moved and 1 students' parent refused testing permission at this time. We have had 2 referrals from 1<sup>st</sup> steps this year that we are finalizing testing on.
- We currently have 69 students with IEP's enrolled in the district preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. We are serving 9 students through Speech Intervening Services.
