RE: Administrator's Report

Title I

- Preschool and Kindergarten took place March 3rd. We screened 72 children this year.
- The 4th monitoring cycle for Federal Programs review has been completed and submitted to DESE.
- The Title program is working to coordinate a Wilson Reading training for elementary staff members over the summer.

Special Education

- We have had 16 referrals for special education services. Six students have qualified for services, six were not eligible and two are in the testing process and two are in the screening.
- We have had six referrals for ECSE services. 4 have qualified and two are in the evaluation process.
- We currently have 75 students with IEP's enrolled in the district preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 10 students through Speech Intervening Services.

Middle School

- MS Track Season starts April 5th with a home meet.
- Parent Teacher Conferences are Wednesday March 15th and Thursday March 16th.
- Bright Futures Kick-Off breakfast will be held April 21st at 7:00 AM at the Knox County Community Center.
