## **Middle School**

## **Federal Programs**

- Parents As Teachers will be holding an activity night centered on music and movement November 19, 2013 at 6:00 pm in the elementary gym.
  
- Special Education staff are currently planning for the MAP-A. We have two students taking the alternate assessment this year. Data collection starts in January. We will also be piloting the new Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) in the winter and spring of this school year. The DLM's will replace the current MAP-A procedures for the 2014-2015 school year.
  
- We have had 3 referrals for special education services. One has qualified for services, one was not eligible and one is currently in the screening process.
  
- We currently have 54 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. We are serving 16 students through Speech Intervening Services.
